Directions to the Sites

Dunellen Public Works, 235 Hall St., Dunellen, 08812

From the North:

Take Route 1 South to I-287 North (Somerville). Take the exit for Rt. 529/Dunellen off of I-287. Merge onto Stelton Road (Rt. 529). Go straight through 3 lights. After passing a Raceway Gas Station on the left, turn left and stay on Stelton Road. (Do not follow Route 529). Go through one light. At the second light (end of road) turn left onto Lakeview Avenue. Almost immediately the road bears to the right. You are now on New Market Road. Just after passing a school on the left (at a triangle) turn left onto Grove St. Go through one light and follow until the road turns into South Avenue (Harry's Deli on right). Go two blocks down and turn left onto Hall St. Dunellen Public Works is at the end of Hall Street on the left.

From the South:

Take Route 1 North to I-287 (Somerville). Take the exit for Rt. 529/Dunellen off of I-287. Merge onto Stelton Road (Rt. 529). Go straight through 3 lights. After passing a Raceway Gas Station on the left, turn left and stay on Stelton Road. (Do not follow Route 529). Go through one light. At the second light (end of road) turn left onto Lakeview Avenue. Almost immediately the road bears to the right. You are now on New Market Road. Just after passing a school on the left (at a triangle) turn left onto Grove St. Go through one light and follow until the road turns into South Avenue (Harry's Deli on right). Go two blocks down and turn left onto Hall St. Dunellen Public Works is at the end of Hall Street on the left.

East Brunswick Reclamation Center (Recycling Center), 357 Dunhams Corner Rd., East Brunswick, 08816

From Rt. 18:

Take Rt. 18 South to Cranbury Road (Rt. 535 South). Bear right at the fork onto Dunhams Corner Rd. and continue for approximately 2.5 miles. The Reclamation Center will be on the right before reaching Church Lane.

From Rt. 130:

Take Rt. 130 North. After passing the sign for the Middlesex County Adult Corrections facility on the right, bear right onto Old Georges Rd. at the sign for Maple Meade. Pass the Church Lane Plaza on the left and turn right onto Church Lane. Follow Church Lane until it ends and turn left onto Dunhams Corner Road. The Reclamation Center will be on the left.

OR

Take Cranbury/South River Rd. (Rt. 535 North) and turn left onto Dunhams Corner Rd. After passing the Crystal Springs Aquatic Center on the right, look for the Reclamation Center on the left, just past Church Lane.

Helmetta, 60 Main St. (behind Borough Hall)

From the Northeast:

Take Rt. 18 to Rt. 615 South. Rt. 615 is also known as Bordentown Ave / Main St. Follow Main St. into Spotswood. Stay on Main St. for about 1 1/2 miles at which point the road splits. Bear left staying on 615 South (green street sign at fork says Manalapan Rd). Continue for just under 2 miles and turn left at the Helmetta Municipal Building. Paint Recycling site is behind Borough Hall.

Helmetta continued

From the West:

Take Rt. 130 to Church Lane (via Georges Rd.). Follow Church Lane east until it intersects with Dunhams Corner Rd. and turn right. Follow Dunhams Corner Rd. until it turns into Helmetta Blvd (at traffic light). Continue until Helmetta Blvd. merges with Lake Ave bearing left at the fork. Make the first right at stop sign (continuing on Lake Ave.) and proceed to Main St. At Main St. turn right and travel about 100 feet to the Helmetta Municipal Building on the left. Paint Recycling site is behind Borough Hall.

Middlesex Borough Recycling Center, 1200 Mountain Ave., Middlesex, 08846

From the South and East:

Take I-287 North to Exit 9 for Highland Park and Bound Brook (or simply take River Rd.) Merge right toward Bound Brook onto River Rd. (Rt. 18) and follow to the end. Turn right onto Lincoln Blvd. Go through 2 lights and at the 3rd light turn left onto Mountain Ave. Go about 5 blocks and turn right onto Monroe Ave (immediately past the Middlesex Presbyterian Church) and continue straight to the Recycling Center and follow the one way signs.

From the North and East:

Take Rt. 28 (Bound Brook Rd.) West and once in Middlesex turn left onto Mountain Ave (Sharp Rite Saw Sharpening Power Tools on right). Pass the Municipal Bldg./Police Headquarters and turn left. Continue straight to the Recycling Center and follow the one way signs.

New Brunswick Public Works, 400 Jersey Ave., New Brunswick, 08901

From the North :

Take the NJ Turnpike South to exit 9 or take Rt. 1 South to Rt. 18 North. Follow Rt. 18 North into New Brunswick and take the exit for Rt. 27 South/Princeton. (or simply follow Rt. 27 South) Merge onto Rt. 27 which is also called Albany St. Make sure you are in the left lane before reaching the 4th light at the New Brunswick train station. Continue going straight. At the 6th light Rt. 27 turns into French St. Before reaching the 8th light, bear left onto Jersey Ave. (at the white clock tower). There will immediately be a light. Continue going straight and follow Jersey Ave. for just under 1 mile. Turn left into the second driveway for the New Brunswick Public Works.

From the South :

Take Rt. 1 North. Take the exit for New Brunswick via Jersey Ave. Follow Jersey Ave. for approximately 2.5 miles (you will go through 1 light). Turn right into the first driveway for the New Brunswick Public Works.

OR

Take Rt. 130 North. Cross over Rt. 1 onto Georges Road. At the 1st light turn left onto Hermann Rd. Follow Hermann Rd. through 1 light. At the 2nd light turn left onto Livingston Ave. Go through 1 light. At the 2nd light turn right onto How Lane (right turn only). Go over the bridge and turn right at the light onto Jersey Ave. Travel just over 1 mile and turn right into the first driveway for the New Brunswick Public Works.

Old Bridge Public Works (at the Municipal Complex), 1 Old Bridge Plaza, Old Bridge, 08857

From Rt. 9: Follow Rt. 9 and take the exit for Rt. 516 East/Matawan. Merge onto Rt. 516 East and travel less than 1/4 mile. Municipal Center will be on the left. Be sure to make a left into the first driveway, and continue through the gate into the recycling drop-off area.

From Rt. 18: Take Rt. 18 South (toward East Brunswick) pass Brunswick Square Mall. Take exit for Matawan/Rt. 516 East. Follow Rt. 516 East for approx. 3 miles. After passing the interchange for Rt. 9, go less than 1/4 mile, the Municipal Center will be on the left. Be sure to make a left into the first driveway, and continue through the gate into the recycling drop-off area.

South Brunswick Recycling Center (at the Municipal Complex), 540 Ridge Road, Monmouth Junction, 08852

From Rt. 1:

Take Rt. 1 to Rt. 522 East (using the jug handle). Cross over Rt. 1, go through three traffic lights and turn left (left turn only) into the Municipal Complex. Once in the parking lot, make an immediate right turn and follow to the stop sign. Turn left and follow the road past the Municipal Building and Public Works building. Turn right opposite Reichier Park into the Recycling Center (behind the skateboard park).

From Rt. 130:

Take Rt. 130 to Rt. 522 West. Go through three traffic lights (approximately 2.5 miles. Turn right into the Municipal Complex. Follow the road past the Municipal Building and Public Works building. Turn right opposite Reichier Park into the Recycling Center (behind the skateboard park).

South Plainfield Recycling Center, Kenneth Ave., South Plainfield, 07080

From I 287:

Take Rt. 287 North and take the Durham Ave./South Plainfield Exit. At the bottom of the exit ramp bear right and merge onto Durham Ave. Go through 1 light. Bear right at the 2nd light and proceed over the bridge (you are now on Hamilton Blvd.). Continue straight until the next light and turn right (right turn only lane) onto Belmont Ave. Travel just under a half a mile and turn right onto Kenneth Ave. (opposite the Public Works Department). Continue going straight on Kenneth Ave. past the James W. Conroy Memorial field on the left. The recycling center will be on the right.

From Rt. 28:

Take Rt. 28 to Rt. 529 South (Washington Ave). Travel about 1 mile. After crossing over New Market Pond, turn left onto Lakeview Ave. (which turns into New Market Ave.). Proceed through 3 lights. At the fourth light, turn right onto Hamilton Blvd. Follow Hamilton Blvd. until the 1st light and turn left onto Belmont Ave. Travel just under a half a mile and turn right onto Kenneth Ave. (opposite the Public Works Department). Continue going straight on Kenneth Ave. past the James W. Conroy Memorial Field on the left. The recycling center will be on the right.

Woodbridge Public Works, 225 Smith St., Keasbey, 08832

From Rt. 1 / NJ Turnpike:

Take either Rt. 1 North or NJ Turnpike North to exit 10 and get onto Rt. 440 N. (east) toward Staten Island. (Rt. 287 South becomes Rt. 440 North). Take the exit for Smith St./Riverside Dr./Fords. Follow the signs for Smith St., bearing left toward Keasbey. Go through one light. Stay in the right lane and turn right at the yellow sign for Woodbridge Public Works, between bridge overpasses. Go down the hill toward the river and turn right, toward the Public Works yard. See guard for unloading instructions.

From Rt. 9 / Rt. 35:

Take Rt. 9 North to Rt. 35 North. Stay in the right lane following signs for Rt. 35 North and go around the circle. Stay right and take the Rt. 35 Victory Bridge across the river. Turn left at the first light onto Smith St. Travel less than 1 mile and stay in the left lane. Just after passing under the bridges, take the left lane U-turn. Immediately get into the right lane and turn right at the yellow sign for Woodbridge Public Works, between bridge overpasses. Go down the hill toward the river and turn right toward the Public Works yard. See guard for unloading instructions.
