to Vote****To participate in the General Election on November 4, 2025**

you must be registered to vote in Middlesex County by Tuesday, October 14, 2025.

Register to vote or update your registration:

- Register to vote online
- Complete and mail in the Voter Registration Application
- In-person at the County Clerk's office or the Board of Elections
- While applying or renewing your driver's license at Motor Vehicles

**Ways
To Vote**

Return your ballot through the United States Postal Service. Mail-in-Ballots must be postmarked on or before 8 pm on election day, November 4, 2025.

Drop your Mail-in-Ballot in a designated Middlesex County Board of Elections drop box by 8 pm on election day, November 5, 2025.

Please contact the Board of Elections at 732-745-3471 or visit our website for convenient ballot drop box locations.

Take your Mail-in-Ballot directly to the Board of Elections Office in East Brunswick by 8 pm on election day, November 4, 2025.

Vote in person at your assigned polling location on election day, November 4, 2025 or at a Middlesex County Early Voting Location from October 25, 2025 to November 4, 2025.

**Vote
by Mail**

Voters must request a mail-in ballot in writing by filling out a Mail-in Ballot Application. A signature is required.

The County Clerk's office must receive Mail-in-Ballot applications by mail no later than October 28 for the General Election.

Voters may apply for a Mail-in-Ballot in person or by authorized messenger at the Office of the County Clerk in East Brunswick up to 3 pm the day before election before the election.

Do not give your ballot to others.

- If someone helped you complete your ballot, they are required to sign the voter assistor portion of the yellow certificate envelope.
- If someone other than you (the voter) is delivering your completed ballot, they must fill out and sign the Bearer Section on the left-front side of the green return envelope and review the guidelines on the back of the envelope.

**Vote
In-Person**

Vote Early at a Middlesex County Early Voting Location Saturday, October 25 – Sunday, November 2, 2025 Monday through Saturday 10am - 8pm and Sunday 10am - 6pm.

Polling locations will be open for in-person voting during the Tuesday, November 4, 2025 (6am to 8pm) General Election. If you wish to vote in person, you may do so at your assigned polling place.
