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## **SOUTH BRUNSWICK WATER DIVISION PRAISED FOR SWIFT RESPONSE TO KINGSTON WATER MAIN BREAK**

SOUTH BRUNSWICK, NJ (OCTOBER 8). The Township of South Brunswick commends its Water Division for their quick and professional actions in assisting with the repair of a water main break that occurred on Monday, September 22, 2025, in Kingston.

At approximately 10:45 a.m., the Water Division was notified of a possible water main break near 40 Fair Acres Court. Upon arrival, the Water Division Foreman discovered that a FIOS contractor, Real Communication, had struck the water main while using a boring machine to run fiber optic cable.

The Water Division immediately shut down the main to stop the water loss and promptly notified the contractor, who was responsible for completing the repair as the break occurred within a private homeowners' association community. When the contractor lacked the proper parts to complete the repair, the Water Division stepped in to supply the necessary clamp, allowing the work to move forward efficiently.

Through their teamwork and proactive support, water service was fully restored by approximately 5:00 p.m. the same day.

Mayor Charlie Carley praised the Division's efforts: *"The Water Division's quick response and willingness to step up ensured that service was restored as quickly as possible. Their dedication to our residents and commitment to problem-solving makes a real difference in our community. I also want to thank residents for their continued patience as our Water Division conducts hydrant flushing throughout town. This essential maintenance work sometimes causes temporary discoloration or rusty water, but it is necessary to keep our water system operating safely and reliably."*
