SOUTH BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP SUPPORTS RENEWABLE ENERGY THROUGH PROPOSED SOLAR CANOPY AT WRV NURSERIES

SOUTH BRUNSWICK, NJ (OCTOBER 9). South Brunswick Township is proud to support WRV Nurseries in its proposed installation of a solar canopy, an initiative that brings renewable, sustainable energy directly to the local community.

The solar canopy is expected to generate approximately **1,800 MWh** of electricity annually—enough to power roughly **168 homes for an entire year**. By producing clean energy without harmful emissions, the project will help improve local air quality, reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and support the Township’s broader climate and sustainability goals.

“This solar canopy is a visible and tangible commitment to a greener future,” said Mayor Charlie Carley. “It demonstrates how public and private partners can work together to bring clean, renewable energy to our community while promoting environmental stewardship.”

The project also serves as a daily reminder of South Brunswick Township’s dedication to sustainability and its efforts to lead by example in the transition to cleaner energy sources.
