

Clean & Safe

All camp staff & the entire facility will be supplied with adequate sanitizing equipment. Each Senior Counselor will be required to wear a backpack with First Aid kits and sanitizing supplies, which include sanitizing gel, wipes, and spray.

Parents may also send their child to camp with their own labeled bottle of hand sanitizer.

MASKS

Face masks are not required, but your camper can wear one whenever they want!

CAR TAGS

Your child will have a color-coded car tag to display on your dashboard for arrival & dismissal. The car tag will match your child's group/pod and must be displayed.

MEDICAL INFO

Please make sure your family has filled out your allergy/anaphylactic form if needed.

SUPPLIES CHECK

Make sure your child has ALL that they need for camp each day.

OUR CAMP Day

What happens each day at Summer Parks Day Camp?



1. Arrival


Enter Woodlot Park and remain in your vehicle at **9:00am.**

Follow the flow of traffic in our “valet” line and stop at the next available orange cone.

At the cone, your child will be greeted by a camp staff member and exit your vehicle to start their day at camp!

While in line, have your child gather their camp items so they can exit the vehicle quickly and safely.

****Arriving promptly at 9:00am is imperative since we will not be accepting late campers this summer.****



2. Camper Groups/Pods

Each camper will be placed in an age-appropriate, color-coded group (pod).



Our groups are:

Purple: Entering 1st Grade

Yellow: Entering 4th Grade

Red: Entering 2nd Grade

Green: Entering 5th Grade

Orange: Entering 3rd Grade

Blue: Entering 6th Grade

3. Daily Schedule



All campers will rotate through a consistent, daily schedule consisting of:

Circle Time, Quiet Time, Art, Nature/Science, Sports, Free Time, Talent Show (weeks 3 & 6) and our Theme Activity games that match up to our daily, fun themes!

All campers will enjoy their snack, and lunch, at the same time at their group's tables under the shady trees in our picnic grove.





4. Eating at Camp



Snack

Each morning, your child will enjoy their snack at their group's table. Please pack snacks your child is able to open themselves.

Lunch

Like snack, all campers will sit with their group to enjoy their lunch at their group's table. Pack lunches in containers your child is able to open themselves and include all needed utensils.

Water Breaks

Your child will have access to multiple sources of water throughout the park to refill their water bottle during the day. **Make sure your child's water bottle is labeled with their full name.**

5. Dismissal



Enter Woodlot Park and remain in your vehicle at **3:00pm.**

Follow the flow of traffic in our “valet” line just like arrival with your color-coded car tags displayed on your windshield.

Your child will meet you at a numbered cone for their pickup.

****Paying attention in line and having your car ready to welcome your children will help move the line along quickly and efficiently.****

6. Daily Themes



This is our daily theme calendar (also available for downloading from our Recreation Website).

Each day of camp will have a special theme.

If your child wishes to wear clothing to match the theme, they may!

****Plan accordingly with the weather and remember, sneakers must be worn each day.****


